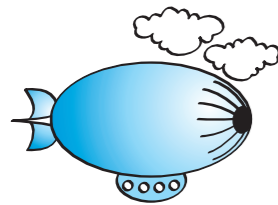


Book 4: Sound and Word Development



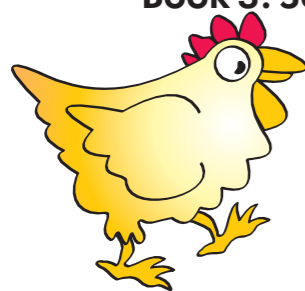
